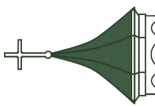

As 2009 comes to an end, I would like to share with you some things the Mission Ministry at WCCC has been involved in this past year.

We share our money with missions from here in Central KY to all over the world. Each one of you who support the work here is a part of this because 10% of our previous year's income is used for missions the following year. Our budget for 2009 was \$83,749.00. We have missions that we commit to with regular support throughout the year, close by and also in foreign countries. We have helped two groups from our church go to Mexico and Haiti this year. We have had 21 different individuals going to Africa, India, Haiti, Jamaica, Ghana, Trinidad, Bulgaria, San Salvador, Russia, east Asia, and Ukraine. Some other places we help support are works in China, the states of Indiana and Washington, Liberty, KY, Lexington, Ky., Cincinnati, OH and many other one-time gifts.

The Mission Ministry committee is made up of several members of our church, Ann Brock, Robert Brock, Mary Boyd, Wanda Dutton, Joe and Judy Clark, John Amshoff, Ethan Buell, Jeff and Cheryl Cook, Jim and Cathy Swearinger, Delores Seybert, Henry and Tracey Wright, Virginia Robinson and myself, Don Robinson, who serves as chair-person.
